



LLA visa Policy

All students coming to LLA must obey the visa regulations of the UK. These regulations will change depending on their country of origin, their status, the amount of time they want to stay and other factors. Each student is responsible for finding the correct information that they need before they try to come to our school. LLA cannot take responsibility for any rejected visas. LLA can only help by providing proof of study for a Short-Term Study visa.

Students must give full and accurate information to LLA at all times during the application process, and this is especially key with students requiring a visa. If a student sends incorrect or incomplete information, it is likely that LLA will not be able to process their application or the visa will be rejected. Students may be recommended to use a partner agency who can help with the visa application. This is only a suggestion and students who do not choose to use that service will not be penalised in any way. Please see our Admission Policy for more details. All students on a visa attached to LLA must abide by UKVI regulations and be aware that any problems or issues will be reported to UKVI.
